## Great Turnout!

November's cold didn't stop the crowd. It was 11 degrees out when we unloaded the first group of cattle for Saturday's clinics, but that didn't stop the dedicated people who came out to learn! We were thrilled with the turnout! 35 people participated in the clinics. NRCHA trainer Joe Harper came up from Kentucky to teach the clinics. Joe was the 2005 and 2006 Open Hackamore National Champion in the NRCHA. Saturday's sorting paid out \$675 in jackpot money. Shade River Ag provided the Preifert pens for the sorting.

Sunday's horse show featured first place plaques provided by Beasley Trucking. We paid out \$380 in jackpot money in the November show, versus \$350 in October. Youth participation was up from 5 runs in October's show to 14 runs in November! The Green had 14 runs, of which 7 participants were new.

We are creating a new class starting with the next show: Rookie Professional. This class will be geared for riders who do not meet non-pro rules but are new to the sport. This class will act as an entry level class for professionals. They will run a reining pattern and then box a cow.

Starting with the March show, we will add a full NRCHA show bill. We will keep the existing ORCHA classes and continue to tabulate points for those classes. There will be \$1,000 added to the NRCHA sanctioned shows. We will also participate in the APHA PAC program. 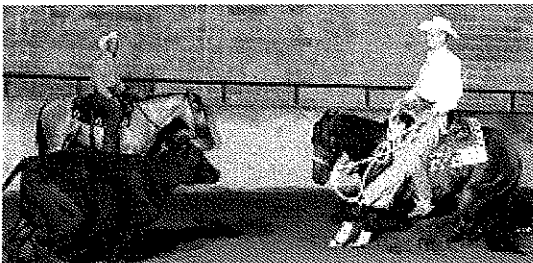

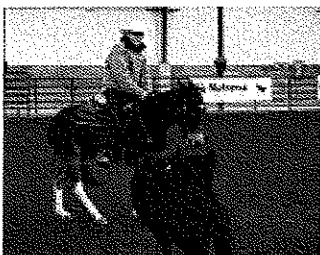
