- All horses must be shown under their registered name (if registered)
- NRCHA Riders:
 - MUST sign the entry form
 - MUST provide complete horse and rider information
 - MUST present current membership cards and horse's registration papers

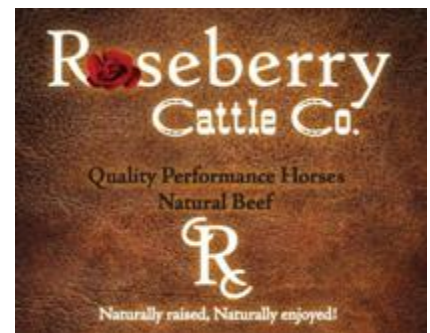

The Rules:

This is a Year End High Point Saddle. You must be an ORCHA member to participate. Points are based on a horse/rider combination. Riders compete in Herd Work, Californio Ranch Riding and their respective NRCHA class to accumulate points. Points are based on the placing within each class. If there is a tie at year end, the total NRCHA class points will be the tie breaker. Points are tracked within a division. The horse/rider combination with the highest points wins the saddle, regardless of division. Riders must declare in advance what division they wish to be tracked and on what horse. Points will only be tracked after a declaration is made. NO backtracking of points. They can only declare one (1) division. Entrants must compete in at least four (4) of the ORCHA 2011 scheduled weekend events. There will be a declaration form available at the March show.
