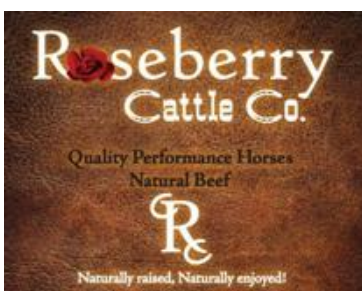

Fee Changes to shows

Due to an unprecedented number of people not paying for stalls used extra days, we have clarified the stall fee schedule. If you arrive between Noon on Thursday and Noon on Friday, the charge is \$90. If you arrive after 12 noon on Friday, its \$70. Between the June and July show, the club has lost \$342 on extra stall days. As a reminder, the person who reserved the stalls is responsible for the bill if the actual owner of the horse does not pay.

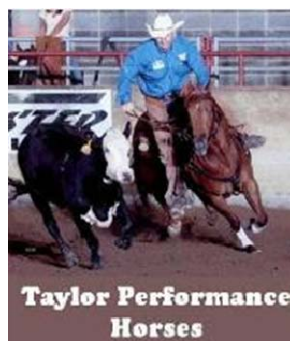
