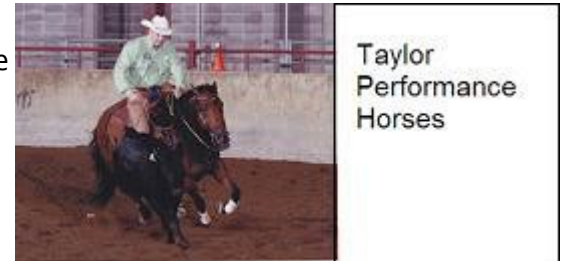
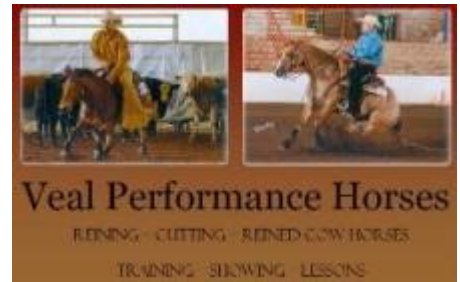

Horse Show Changes

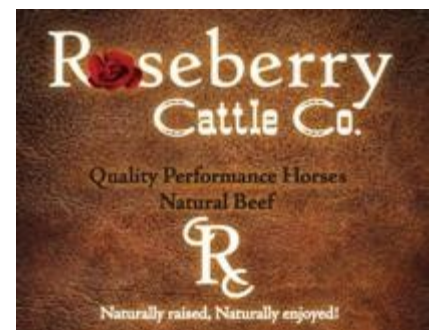
Just a couple changes for 2010:
