Derby Announced!

The November 6-8 show will feature a Derby as well as AQHA cutting and cow horse in addition to 2 full NRCHA class sets. We are still in the planning stages and we need to work on sponsors for the added money! Information is on the ORCHA website now. More details will be posted as they become available.

Please be aware that the Derby will be pre-entry only. Entries will be due October 15th. Horse show entries can enter the day of the show. The Derby will consist of Herd work, Rein Work and Fence Work. We will offer Open, Limited Open, Non Pro, Amateur and Limited Non Pro Derby Classes. The tentative schedule:

The Derby Herd Work and AQHA and ORCHA cutting will take place on Friday November 6th. All paid warm ups will be on Friday. (herd and fence)

Rein work will be Saturday morning followed by the NRCHA approved horse show #1 with AQHA approved Cow horse. Derby Fence work and Horse Show #2 will be on Sunday.

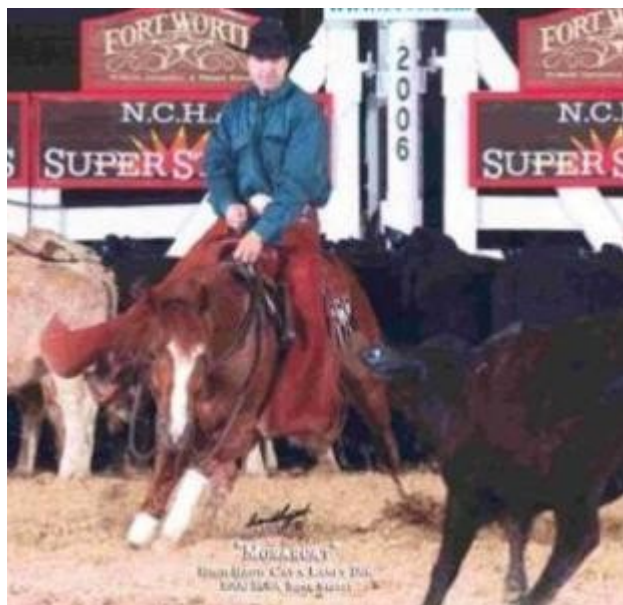

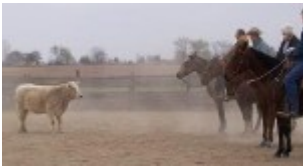

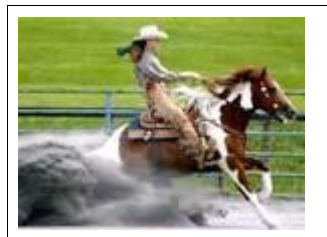
