ORCHA Green I - simplified pattern: no flying lead change, no sliding stop, only 1 or 1 1/2 spins
Rider can ride 2 hands, in any bridle, regardless of horse's age

ORCHA Green II - simplified pattern: flying lead change, attempt sliding stop, only 2 or 2 1/2 spins
Rider starts one hand and ends one hand, but may switch to 2 hands if needed. Any bridle.

ORCHA Youth - simplified pattern: simple lead change, attempt sliding stop, spin as pattern reads
Headgear should be appropriate to the horse's age and be NRHA or NRCHA legal.
Horses 6 and older: ride one handed in bridle.
Horses 5 and younger: 2 handed in snaffle or bosal.

All other classes - Headgear should be appropriate to the horse's age and be NRHA or NRCHA legal.
Horses 6 and older: ride one handed in bridle.
Horses 5 and younger: 2 handed in snaffle or bosal.
