Deadline to enter the Ohio Reined Cow Horse Association's 2010 Heartbreak Ridge Performance Horses Derby, along with the newly added Ohio Reined Cow Horse Snaffle Futurity and Stallion Stakes, is Friday, October 15. Late entries will be accepted with a \$100 late fee.

Hosted by the National Reined Cow Horse Association's 2009 Affiliate of the Year, Ohio Reined Cow Horse Association, the October 29-November 1 Derby weekend culminates a 2010 events season that is on track to pay out more than \$38,000 for the year!

With \$2,750 added for the Derby alone, the weekend boasts \$6,775 in cash in prizes for the entire weekend. Derby weekend will also include two NRCHA-sanctioned shows with \$1,000 added each day. In addition to cash, prizes include CR Morrison Bronze for Open Derby Champion and CR Morrison Plaques for all other division Champions.

The weekend excitement comes to a close with a Monday clinic, by the judge, renowned trainer and only woman to win the Snaffle Bit Futurity, Sandy Collier.
