A Bob's Custom Boyd Rice Cow Horse Saddle, provided by Rod's Western Palace, to the Ohio Reined Cow Horse Association's year-end high point winner of The Extreme Cow Horse Saddle Series.

Open to any ORCHA member, the year-end award will be based on points accrued by one horse/rider combination competing in Herd Work, Californio Ranch Riding and their respective NRCHA class. Points are based on the placing within each class. If there is a tie at year end, the total NRCHA class points will be the tie breaker. Points are tracked within a division and the horse/rider combination with the highest points wins the saddle, regardless of division.

Riders must declare in advance the horse, the division and the NRCHA class they want points to count towards the high point saddle provided by Rod's Western Palace.

Extreme Cow Horse Saddle Series competitors must compete in at least four of the ORCHA 2011 scheduled weekend events.
