The Ohio Reined Cow Horse Association Returns to Jackson July 23-25!

NRCHA-Sanctioned Horse Show Offers \$1,000 Added Each Day!

The National Reined Cow Horse Association's 2009 Affiliate of the Year, Ohio Reined Cow Horse Association's 2010 events schedule continues with a NRCHA-sanctioned Horse Show at Henderson Arena in Jackson, OH, July 23-25, 2010.

The weekend's show will start with herd work on Friday, July 23, with the two NRCHA -sanctioned horse show beginning Saturday, July 24 and Sunday, 25 with \$1,000 added each day.

The July show will be judge by well-respected California trainer Mark Matson. Originally from Ohio, Matson's accomplishments include the 2006 Limited Champion Hackamore Classic, 2006 Reserve Champion Hackamore Classic, 2005 NRCHA Open Hackamore World Champion, Founding Member of the Southern California Rein Cow Horse Association, and President of the Valley Cow Horse Association President for 2009 and 2010.

"I love coming to Ohio shows because everyone is so enthusiastic about learning how to do the sport of the reined cow horse," says Matson.

"Last time I was there (2009 Heartbreak Ridge Performance Horses Derby), I think I judged until almost 2 am on Saturday night. That is great to see that much interest in the sport I love. I hope to see that the level of interest and enthusiasm, on this trip, is even higher than before."

The ORCHA June show had the most entries and pay out so far for 2010, with 328 entries, \$6,350 was paid out. So far, the three shows of 2010 have paid out more than \$20,000.

The 2010 show season will culminate with the Heartbreak Ridge Performance Horses Derby, newly added ORCHA Futurity and Stallion Stakes, as well as a clinic by renowned trainer and only woman to win the Snaffle Bit Futurity, Sandy Collier, October 29-November 1.
